



MORANG, SISTER MARY AMBROSE Grand Rapids Sister Mary Ambrose Morang, OP of Grand Rapids (born Marie Ann Morang in Chicago, IL) died February 3, 2012. She was 96 years old and a Dominican Sister for 73 years. Sr. Mary A. was engaged in Catholic education for over forty years. These years were almost evenly divided between assignments in Michigan (twenty-two years) and New Mexico (twenty-one years). Her teaching assignments in Michigan were in: Alpena, Saginaw, Allen Park, Essexville, Munger, Ravenna, Chesaning; and Merrill. In New Mexico she taught in Albuquerque, Belen; and Alameda. Sister Mary A. was a woman with many interests and talents. Among them were reading, music, arts and crafts, painting, sewing, culinary arts, foreign languages, and archaeology. She availed herself of every opportunity for new educational experiences. In 1991 she was the recipient of a fifth certificate for earning one hundred clock hours of continuing education at Aquinas College Emeritus Center. Sister Mary A. is survived by her sister Stephanie, Mrs. Leonard Sielski of Manistee; nieces, nephews, many friends and a loving Community. Sister Mary A. will repose at Chapel of the Word, Marywood Health Center, 111 Lakeside Dr. NE in Grand Rapids with visitation on Monday, February 6 from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. The Remembering Service will be on Monday at 7:00 p.m. at Dominican Chapel / Marywood, 2025 East Fulton Street.
