

The School Advisory Committee – Our Catholic school represents our major outreach in the area of formation and education of children and youth and their families. Tim Fischer serves as chairperson, and Mary Lou Racine serves as vice-chairperson. As with the other leadership groups with the Catholic Community, there are eight sub-committees within the School Advisory Committee. These sub-committees consist of:

- The **Strategic Planning Committee** is working to create and recommend a 10-year plan for the school.
- The **Building and Grounds Committee** will work in collaboration with the similar committee from the Finance Council to ensure that the school facilities and grounds are maintained.
- The **Budget and Finance Committee** will work in collaboration with the CCM Finance Council to ensure that the school budget stays within its approved targets.
- The **Marketing/Enrollment/Public Relations Committee** will work at developing on-going marketing and public relation goals to recruit and retain students and families.
- The **Development/Grant Writing Committee** will continue to seek out third funding revenue resources not only for the school, but also for the parish.
- The **Catholic Identity Committee** will use various national and diocesan benchmarks to make sure that MCC continues its long-time tradition of being a Catholic School, teaching and reflecting the Gospel values of Jesus Christ.
- The **Technology Committee** will work at creating a plan to ensure that students and faculty of MCC will be equipped with the technology they need for a 21st century academic institution.
- The **Policy Committee** will review our present school handbooks to make sure they are in line with the new Diocese of Gaylord School Policy Book, as well as with State of Michigan mandates regarding health and safety of students.
